

**REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

A FARMER'S MARKET/CO-OP/EDUCATIONAL GREENHOUSE**

The Town of Springerville has been awarded a federal Rural Business Development Grant from United States Department of Agriculture for a temporary contracted position TO DEVELOP A MULTI USE PROGRAM FOR A FARMER'S MARKET/CO-OP AND EDUCATIONAL GREENHOUSE. Qualifications will be accepted thru April 20th, 2017 at 5:00 pm.

The Co-op office and greenhouse will be used as a multi use facility for entrepreneurs including a component for an incubator where interested parties would learn how to fine tune their business skills; An educational component instruction on various topics (i.e., growing sustainably for profit and family), developing/running a farmer's market and working with the Non-profit board. Knowledge in the following is preferable:

- Setting up a farmer's market (including seeking vendors, set up and accountability of running a farmer's market every weekend during the spring-fall months for the Apache County Region
- Background in hydroponics, educational programs for various growing methodologies, working with interested parties to support entrepreneurial growth, health and nutrition and environmental sustainability.
- Experience in the operations of a non-profit environment is desirable

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
