He also stated he wanted two officers and the police chief fired/suspended without pay for in his opinion also not doing anything with his complaint that has gone on since February.

Councilmember MacKenzie reported that in talking with the person who did the Chrome in the Dome is going to come and report on the event. He noted that the event was very successful and they hope to do it again next year.

Manager West reported on behalf of our Public Works Director Tim Rasmussen that they will be doing residential door to door notifications regarding radium levels. He explained that testing is done every quarter based on a running annual average of four quarters. This quarters testing level was 4.4 but due to a previous high level it averaged out at 5.075 which is only 1/10 over the MCL of 5.0 pCi/L.
