8. Race Wars Arizona: Presentation by Race Wars Arizona and possible council action regarding the use of the Airport for a racing event this fall.

Preet Singh, Rob Barkley and Joshua Neps addressed the council regarding the possible use of the airport for an event of rove racing. They explained that this was not drag racing but roll racing that won't pull up any asphalt. They said they would like to make the Springerville Municipal their new home for this event noting that for the past two years they've held this in Gila Bend and brought in over 10,000 people.

They have an interest in bringing people to Springerville and utilizing the local merchants for their shopping and overnight stays. They also said that they donate some of the profits to local charitable organizations. They explained that they have people that follow this event that draws large crowds.

Due to the large amount of people in attendance they outgrew Gila Bend. He further noted that they carry their own liability insurance that would name Springerville as additional insured on this event.

Airport Manager Sean Keinle said he was excited about having this event at the airport but had concerns with emergency flights with Med-Evac. They stated this wouldn't be an issue as they could clear the area within five minutes of being notified.

In response to Mayor Nedrow's question about noise in the evening, they said that the event would start at 7:00 a.m. and end at 5:00 p.m. and they would be doing their own clean up after the event.

They asked the council to allow them to have the Race Wars at the airport in October.
