Candidate Names To Appear on the August 2nd Primary Election Ballot

The Primary Election is Tuesday, August 2, 2022, with two Council member seats to fill four-year terms and one direct elect Mayor to fill a four-year term on the ballot. If all the seats are not filled, a General Election will be held Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Any candidate who receives more than 50% of the vote at the Primary Election is considered elected. If vacant seats are not filled at the Primary, a General Election will be held for the remaining seats. Candidates are added to the General Election ballot based on the vote total they received at the Primary, but no more than two candidates per unfilled seat may be placed on the ballot.

Four candidates filed nomination papers to run for the two Council member seats. One candidate filed nomination papers to run for the Mayor seat. All terms will expire December 2026. The following names will appear on the August 2 Primary Election ballot:

Town Council Seat: Doug Henderson, Florencio Lozoya-Soto, Tom Candelaria, and Phil Hanson Jr.

Mayor Seat: Shelly Reidhead
