### TOWN OF EAGAR & SPRINGERVILLE FUEL STATION UPDATES

Dear Residents:

The Towns of Eagar and Springerville wish to make everyone aware of the changes coming to the Town of Eagar that will have an impact on the valley. First, Short Stop is having work completed on their fuel tanks to meet industry standards. This work will begin on the 16<sup>th</sup> of October and continue until all work is completed, lasting about 45 business days. Inside operations will continue as normal providing it is safe to do so. The second is that the long-awaited new Circle K construction will be beginning. Although there is not a firm date for the beginning of construction, we have been made aware that fuel sales will no longer occur after October 10<sup>th</sup> as hardware inside the facility is being moved out. Representatives of Circle K have stated a year shutdown time from that date which will limit fuel facilities in Eagar. Staff from both communities reached out to Circle K in Springerville, Bradco Pacific Pride/Express24, and Gateway, ensuring the organizations were aware of these changes and prepared for a greater demand at each location. Bradco Pacific Pride/Express24 informed us that changes were made at the location to allow Visa and Mastercard holders to purchase fuel without a membership. As always, your continued patience is appreciated during these construction timeframes.
